| Rummage around your home and start collecting unwanted items that can be used for construction projects. You'll need adhesives (blue tac, glue, tape etc), fasteners (paper clips, string, wire, pipe cleaners) and building materials (paper, cardboard, foil, polystyrene, popsticks, straws, modelling clay, egg cartons, cardboard tubes, bubble wrap etc). Please get permission to use the items. You'll need a ruler or tape measure, scissors and a box or basket to store items. | Design a board game with an Australian Democracy theme. First, make a list of rewards (move forward) and penalties (move backwards). Use what you know about democracy in Australia to create a board game. Australian democracy is based on the following principles: freedom of election and being elected; freedom of assembly and political participation; freedom of speech, expression and religious belief; rule of law; and other basic human rights. Examples of rewards and penalties: reward - "You helped at the sausage sizzle on voting day. Move forward 3 spaces." Penalty - "You forgot to vote and received a fine in the mail! Go back 5 spaces." | Write a song or poem about your favourite sport or animal. For a song, it might be easier if you think of a tune you already know and match your lyrics (words) to that tune. Remember that poems don't have to rhyme. | Find your favorite doll or action figure and design a zip line to get them from one level to another (tree to ground, table to floor). A paper clip might be handy! | Build a tower as tall as possible using only sheets of newspaper. No tape or glue allowed! Newspaper only. |

Continue Instrument Practice. | Every Friday make time to write a few paragraphs about your week and anything you might be looking forward to next week. Use interesting adjectives and remember to include all punctuation. Try to include complex sentences. Eg. While Dad was trying to tell a joke, Survivor came on tv and everyone ignored him. |

| Make a floor plan of your room on grid paper. Measure the dimensions and draw items to scale. Remember to draw from bird's eye view. Imagine you are on the ceiling looking down. | | Create your own experiment using baking soda + vinegar. Write the experiment up with your predictions prior to completing it. | Go outside and find a quiet place. Use your senses and write everything you can see, smell, hear, touch and feel inside for 10 minutes. Eg distant chirping, calm, cloud shaped like a rabbit. | Create a secret code using numbers or symbols. Write a letter and see if someone in your family can solve the secret message when given the code. |
