

VISUAL ART: 1-2 CHOICE BOARD

Take photos of your creations if you can and email them to your teacher!

Draw and color a picture with only **cool colours**.



Gather rocks, sticks, leaves from your garden. Arrange your materials into a **pattern, picture or portrait of a person or animal!**

Use playdough, salt dough (look up a recipe) or air-dry clay to create your own **sculptures, favourite animals, people or characters**.

Use found objects to make a **sculpture**: paper rolls, foil, recyclables, etc.

Cut out facial features from a magazine and glue them onto a piece of blank paper or card to create a funny face **collage**.
