Draw your **favourite teacher** like a cartoon character.

Google **'The Colour wheel'**. Find items around your house to create your own.

Research **Origami**. Find a design you would like to create. Teach someone else how to do it too.



Go outside and draw a **Landscape**. Be sure to show the horizon line (where the ground meets the sky).

Create an **Animal Hybrid**: draw two animals combined to create a new creature!



Listen to music. Draw **lines and shapes** as you listen to match the sounds, rhythms and moods. See what you create.

Draw or use a camera or mobile phone to capture different **viewpoints** of the same object.

Use household items (cardboard, packaging, containers) to create a **sculpture**.



Draw or take a picture of examples of each of the **art elements** (line, colour, shape, texture, value, form, space).

Draw a contour line of a shape you like (eg. animal, tree, cloud) and fill it with **zentangle** patterns



Recreate an **illustration** from a favourite book.

Gather 3-5 objects and arrange them to draw or paint a **still life**.
